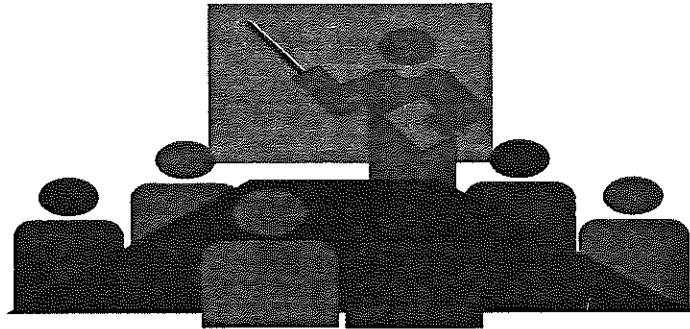
Annual Meeting to be Held May 12

Fairfax County Supervisor Gerry Connolly to Discuss Local Concerns Agenda Will Also Include Roadwork, Election of Board Members

The annual meeting of all City Park Civic Association members will be held Wednesday, May 12th, at 7:30 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Devonshire Center at 2831 Graham Road.

The Devonshire Center is located close to Lee Highway, on the opposite side of the street from Magruder's Supermarket. Parking is available at the rear of the building, on the north side.

Our guest will be Providence District Supervisor Gerry Connolly, who will address regional transportation concerns and other topics of interest to our community.



Elections

Five positions on the Board of Directors are up for election:

Three directors due to the expiring two-year terms of Bill Carrington, Jane Chapman, and Ed deWolfe.

One director to complete the one-year remainder of Duncan Cameron's term. Mr. Cameron is resigning from the board due to his impending move out of City Park Homes.

One director to fill a vacancy which has existed since the resignation of Jim Weedon in December 1998.

Nominations will be accepted from the floor. All members in good standing, including incumbents, are eligible for nomination, except that the Association's bylaws prohibit more than

one member of the same household from serving on the Board at the same time. The nominee must agree to serve if elected.

One-year memberships in the City Park Civic Association expired on March 1. If your membership has expired, or if you're not a CPCA member, please take a moment to complete the application form attached to this newsletter and bring it to the meeting. Your membership will be renewed and be effective at that time.
